


SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONES POLAND

Polish Investment Zone


On the base of legal act of May 10, 2018 on supporting new investments Poland is one big special economic zone (SEZ) offering a lot of incentives for SMEs and Large companies / investors / companies expanding. SEZ area in Poland consists of 14 zones

Leading sectors by public support in Polish Investment Zone



don:

Areas **excluded** from public aid

-  Production of explosives
-  Production of alcohol and tobacco products
-  Construction works
-  Wholesale and retail trade
-  Distribution sector (excluding: warehouse and storage)
-  Insurance and financial services
-  Accommodation and catering services
-  Energy and gas generation and distribution sectors
-  Companies from the metallurgy, iron and steel sectors, the coal
-  Collection, transport, recovery and disposal of waste

Eligible costs incurred while the decision on the support is in force

Investment expenditure



-  the cost of the acquisition of land or perpetual usufruct of land
-  the cost of the rental or lease of land, buildings and objects
-  the purchase price or the own manufacturing cost of fixed assets
-  the cost of the extension or modernisation of existing fixed assets
-  the purchase price of intangible assets in relation to the technology transfer through the acquisition of patent, licensing rights, know-how and unpatented technical knowledge
-  the purchase price of assets, excluding land, buildings and objects subject to rental or lease as long as the rental or lease takes place in the form of financial lease and includes a commitment to purchase the assets upon the expiry of the rental or lease period

Two-year labour costs



Costs incurred by entrepreneur, for a defined period of time, in creating new work places related to investment implementation.

Labour cost of newly employed workers, including costs of gross salaries, increased by compulsory contributions, such as social security contribution, incurred by entrepreneur from the day of employment.

Labour costs of newly employed employees including costs of gross salaries of these employees increased by other obligatory payments.
